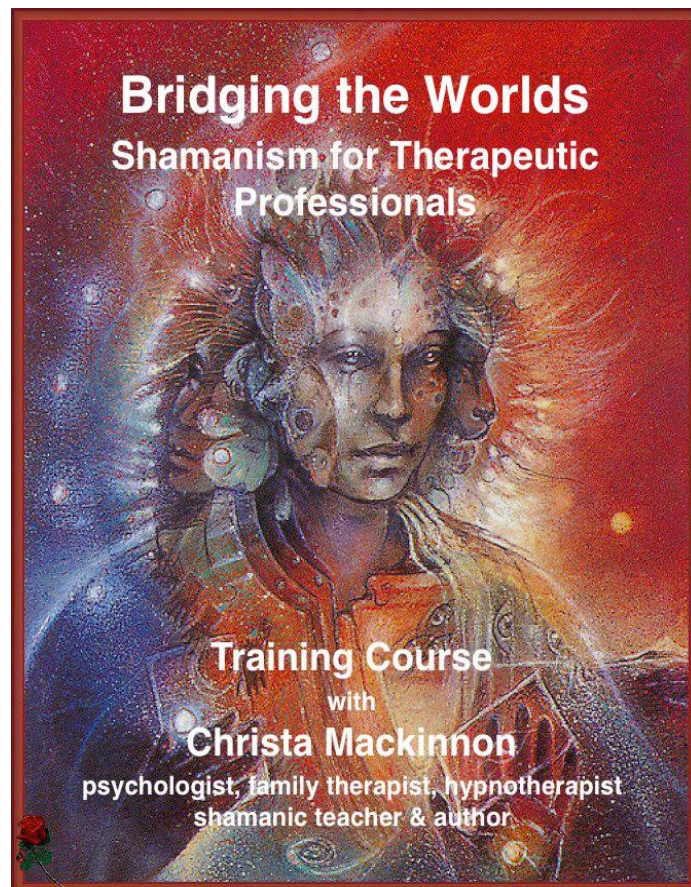


Bridging the Worlds
